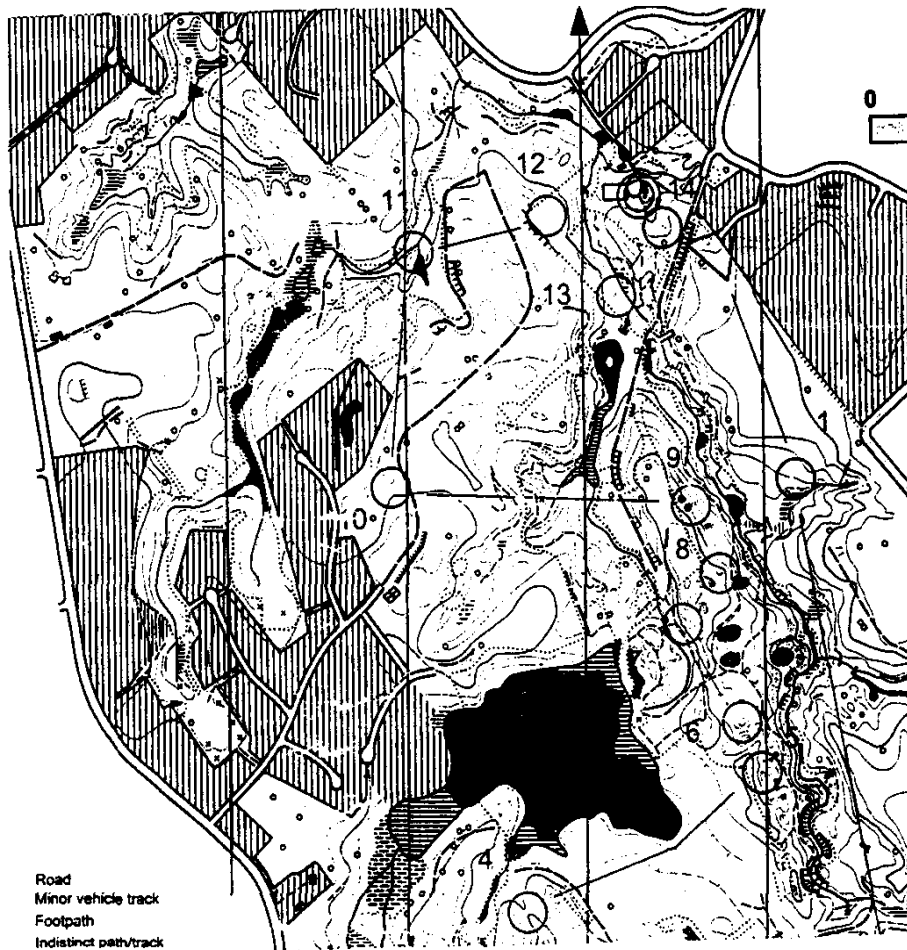

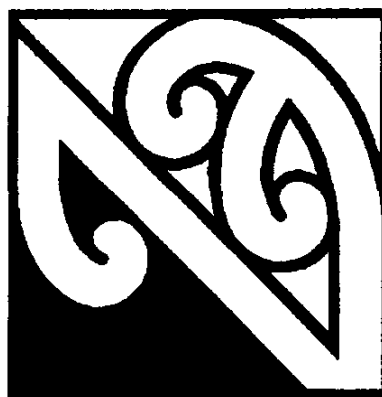

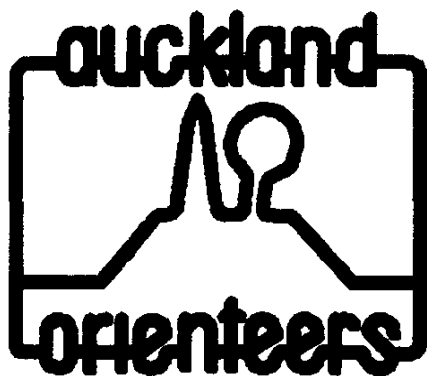

## Spring Series Handicaps

A handicap system was introduced for the first time in last year's Spring Series events. The final results from the series were surprisingly close, with a tie for first place and a good mixture of different grades following behind. As the concept of the handicap system for the series proved to be popular, it will be repeated this year with some modifications to the way the handicap factors are calculated.

Last year the handicaps were based purely on performances in the five preceding OY events, adjusted by the handicappers where they considered it necessary. This year the handicaps are based on all events run in Auckland and surrounding areas during the last two years, and using each competitor's five best performances from their last ten events. The handicaps are in the form of a multiplier factor with the fastest person rated at 1.00 and individual ratings rounded to the nearest 5%. These factors will be used to adjust a competitor's time in the Spring Series events to arrive at handicap placings.

Points will be awarded based on the handicap placings for each of the red courses offered during the series, 50 points for first, 49 for second, etc. and the best four results from the five events will count for each competitor. Only financial members of clubs are eligible for points.

There is only one competition covering all competitors who run the red courses in the series. The only rule is that competitors who run in the OY series on courses 1 or 2 i.e. in M21E, W21E, M21A & M40A grades, must run in the long red course. All other competitors can run in whichever course they like.

Another change from last year is that the results of these events will be included in the handicap system so your handicap may be adjusted as the series progresses.

As an example, assume we have the following four orienteers —

Fred Steel	M21E	.90 factor
Polly Cousins	W40A	.50 factor
Gael Black	W21AS	.35 factor
Jim Crusoe	M50A	.65 factor

At the first event Fred must run the long course and takes 50 minutes, Polly chooses to run the long course and takes 75 minutes while Gael and Jim run course 2 in 70 minutes and 38 minutes respectively. Assuming no other competitors the results would look like this —
